Additions include Germany’s highest water slide and Europe’s biggest tropical sauna & spa complex – a milestone in the development of Tropical Islands. With the opening of the Tropical Islands Campsite, the construction of numerous lodges, the addition of a sun-bed deck by the Tropical Sea and the inauguration of the Fitness Club, Tropical Islands once again set new standards. New daytime and evening shows were unveiled in February 2010. Thanks to this continuous process of development, Tropical Islands retains its appeal for guests and is becoming increasingly well-known in Germany and across Europe.

The objective of Tropical Islands is to become the leading European holiday resort. Together with the nearby Spreewald region, it would like to position itself as a Europe-wide travel destination.
