Water fun in the Tropical Sea and Bali Lagoon

The Tropical Sea

Tropical Islands offers tropical water fun and pure holiday feeling.

With an area of 3,000 square metres, the Tropical Sea alone is the size of four Olympic swimming pools. A shallow paddling area with children's slide, tilting buckets and fountain is ideal for the youngest guests. There they can immerse themselves in 28°C warm water! The artificial horizon on the edge of the pool gives the feeling of a holiday far away in distant locations. A 200 metre long sandy beach borders the generously sized stainless steel pool. Several hundred deckchairs are located there on the new sunbed deck - ideal for relaxing with a book or for acquiring a natural tan. A 20,000 square metre transparent foil lets the sun's radiation in.

Clear tropical water ensures great, safe bathing fun, especially for the youngest visitors. The **water quality** at Tropical Islands is excellent and is therefore also suitable for toddlers and people with sensitive skin. One of the most modern systems in Europe ensures that the water in all bathing areas is filtered around the clock and is adequately replaced with fresh water. In addition, the water is under permanent electronic control: Each pool has measuring equipment which monitors the hygienic properties of the water and ensures the bathing water is properly disinfected. However, to ensure unspoilt bathing fun, disinfectants are only used with the necessary concentration. For this reason, the chlorine values are at the lowest limit of the concentrations specified by law. This is possible through modern treatment processes. In this way, Tropical Islands fulfils the highest hygiene standards and therefore allows all bathing guests to enjoy unlimited swimming pleasure.

Refreshing drinks and ice creams are available from the **two beach bars** "Aloha" and "Kaikala". You can also watch the lively activities in the water from the "Palm Beach" restaurant close to the beach. Here you can enjoy à la carte meals: From baked potatoes with sour cream and herbs to crispy salads and fillet steak, the menu has something for every taste.

The Bali Lagoon

The 1,200 square metre Bali Lagoon is embedded in the tropical rainforest. A water temperature of 32°C guarantees perfect relaxation. Grotto and waterfall at the edge of the rainforest create an exotic tropical feeling. Easy going water fun is provided by a flow channel, water slides and whirlpools.

In the evening the lagoon is romantically lit. Numerous deckchairs in the white sand on the shore provide adequate comfort. Two Balinese huts, the roar of the waterfall and the view of the lagoon transport guests into an enticing exotic world.

Made Wijaya (name at birth: Michael White) designed the Bali Lagoon. Born in Australia, he travelled to Bali during his architectural studies in 1973 and has lived there ever since. The representative of the art of exotic gardening has designed more than 600 gardens, especially tropical gardens, all over the world.
