The Tropical Sea

Tropical Islands is the ideal location for a tropical bathing experience and pure holiday bliss.

At 3,000 m², the Tropical Sea alone is as big as three Olympic swimming pools. The shallow paddling area is perfect for small children, with junior slides, tipping buckets and fountains. Guests of all ages can immerse themselves in the wonderfully warm (28°C) water. The artificial horizon at the edge of the pool recreates the feeling of holidaying in far-away climes, and the stainless steel pool is fronted by 200 metres of sandy beach with hundreds of sun loungers. Those who want to relax a little further away from the water can retreat to the sunbathing deck for a quiet read or to get that natural suntan. The sunlight shines in through a 20,000 m² panel on the south side of the dome.

The clear tropical water guarantees great, safe fun, especially for our youngest guests. The **water quality** at Tropical Islands is excellent, suitable even for small children and visitors with sensitive skin. One of the most modern water treatment systems in Europe ensures that the water in all the pool areas is filtered all around the clock and replaced with sufficient fresh water. In addition to this, the water is also under permanent electronic control: each pool is fitted with measuring equipment that monitors the hygienic quality of the water and ensures that it is properly disinfected. In order to ensure that our customers' bathing experience remains unspoiled, only the necessary quantities of disinfectants are added to the water. For this reason, the chlorine levels remain at the lowest possible threshold in compliance with legal regulations. This would be impossible without the modern water treatment process we use, which ensures that Tropical Islands meets the highest hygiene standards and allows our guests a highly enjoyable bathing and swimming experience.

The two **beach bars**, Aloha and Kaikala, provide refreshing drinks and ice cream. Close to the beach, the Palm Beach restaurant is also the perfect location from which to watch the fun in the pool, and serves an à la carte menu ranging from baked potatoes with herb cream dressing and crunchy salads through to fillet steaks – in short, something for everyone.

The Bali Lagoon

The 1,200 m² Bali Lagoon is hidden deep in the tropical rainforest. A water temperature of 32°C ensures maximum relaxation, while the cave and waterfall create the perfect tropical ambience. The whirl stream, the water slides and the whirlpools offer plenty of opportunity for fun in this pool.
